Feb 06 ,2025

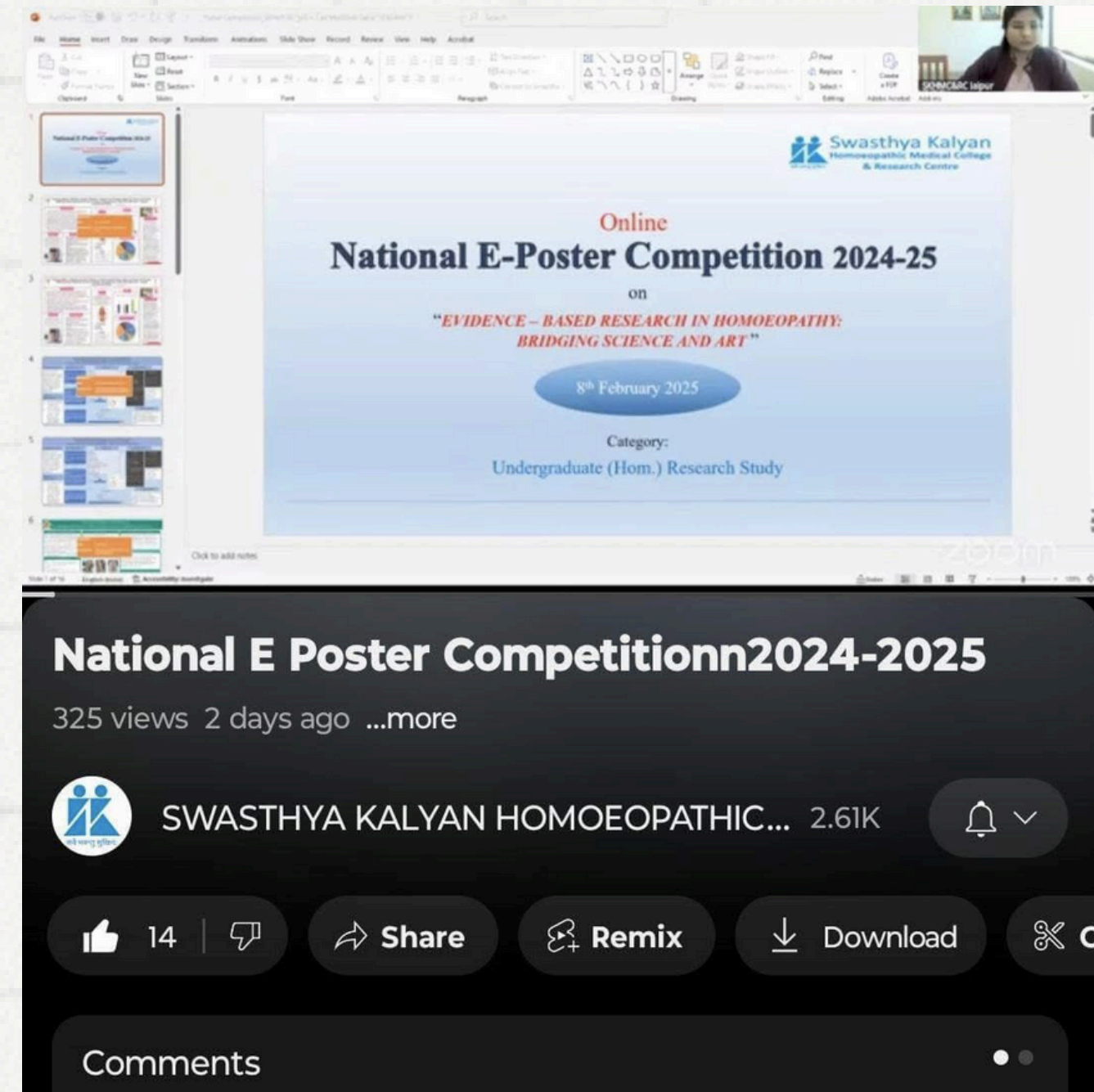
