05-Sep-25

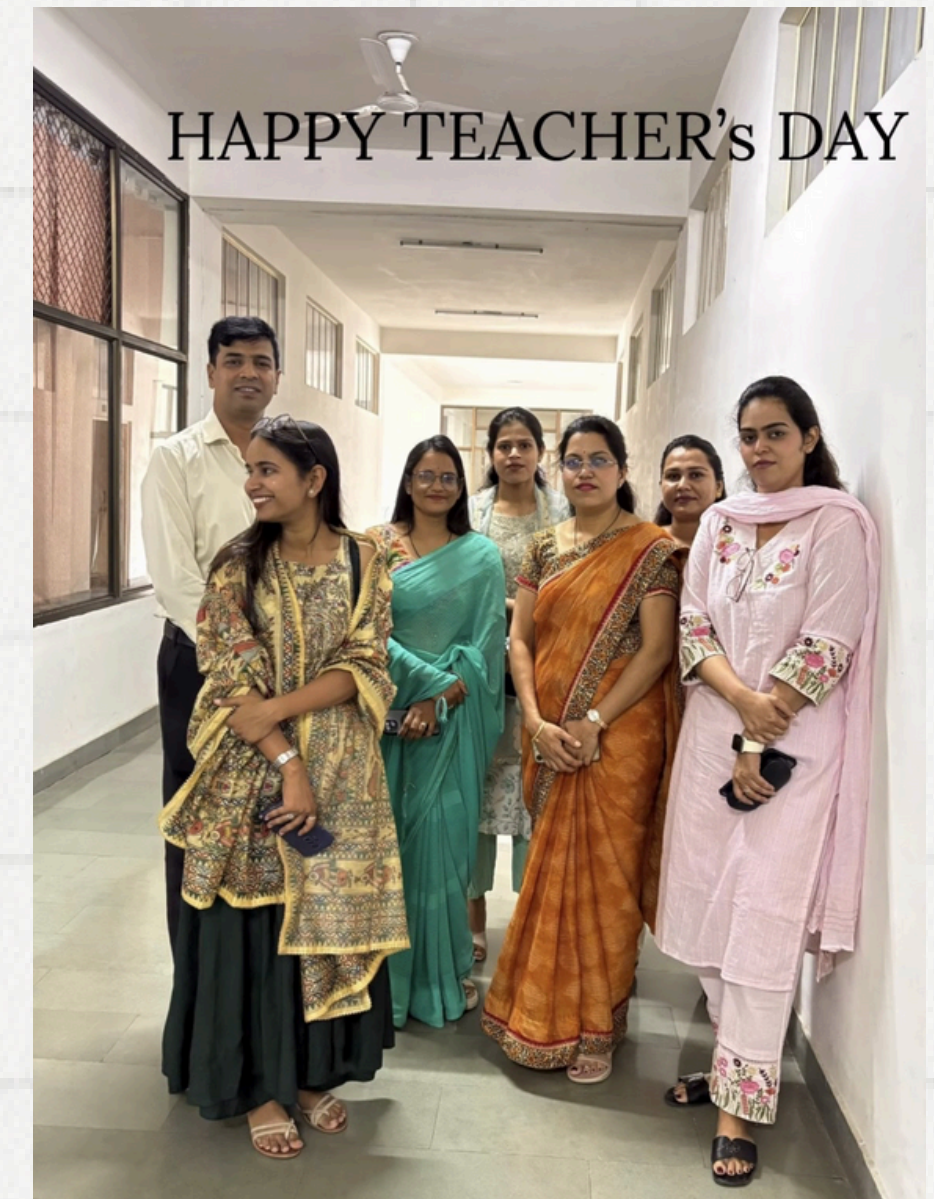
